Parenting with Love and Logic is an approach to raising kids that teaches parents how to provide loving support for their children while also holding them accountable for their actions with empathy and understanding. Using the *Early Childhood Parenting Made Fun* program, parents will learn to

- ♥ Show kids that whining and arguing do not pay
- ♥ Put an end to misbehavior in public
- ♥ Smooth-out mornings and bedtimes
- ♥ Calm sibling bickering and battling
- ♥ Teach respect, responsibility, and self-discipline
